CHECKLIST FOR SEDATED EXAMS



Before the exam

- <u>No food</u> after midnight (Water is OK).
- Patient drop-off will be between 7:00-8:00am.
- Bring all your <u>medications in their original-labeled bottle</u>, <u>special diet</u>, and/or <u>e-</u> <u>collar(plastic cone)</u> with you. We will refill what is needed
- If your pet needs to take medications the morning of the exam, please call Sirius Vet, at least 1 day in advance, to make sure the medication will not counteract with any treatments planned for your pet.
- If an estimate has been provided for the proposed treatments and/or sedation, the low end of the estimate will be collected as a <u>deposit</u> when we call to confirm your appointment.
- We will schedule a pick-up appointment with you for the afternoon.
- You will be contacted as soon as we are finished and will confirm the pick up appointment.

Afternoon following a sedated exam

- **Discharge** will typically take 10-15 minutes.
 - Discharge will consist of <u>final payment</u>, scheduling <u>recheck appointments</u>, and going over discharge instructions.
 - We will discuss medications, give you some exercises to do at home, review and answer any additional questions.
- It is not uncommon for your pet to be a little **<u>sleepy</u>** or **<u>wobbly</u>** when they go home.

• There may be a bandage over the <u>IV catheter</u> site. This can be removed when you get home.

Feel free to **<u>call</u>** the clinic with any questions. We will try to contact you within twenty four(24) to forty eight(48)hours.

* If you have an **emergency** please do not wait for a call back and head to the closest emergency veterinary clinic.
